The replacement windows will be made at our local Pella plant and local contractors will be used for the installation. Contributions raised to save this historic building will be returned to the community through manufacturing and construction jobs.

Replacing the windows is part of the ongoing plan to turn an underused building into useable space for the community as well as house the Western Illinois Museum, the Macomb Area Convention and Visitors Bureau, and the McDonough County Genealogical Society.
